Miscellaneous:

- **Wavier and Release of Liability:** Every competitor must have a signed DNSC Waiver and Release of Liability form and either be a USSA Member or have a signed USSA Waiver and Release of Liability
- **Racing Bibs:** Bibs will be collected after the qualifying and re-issued for the Heats. We will collect racing bibs after Saturday's race and re-issue for the Sunday's race. Team Bibs will be at the World Class Ski Stadium for Sunday's race at the Durango Mountain Resort Nordic Center.
- **Bathrooms:** There is a bathroom near the start - finish area at Hillcrest Golf Course. There will also be porto potties near the start - finish area. There is a bathroom at the Fire Station next to the Nordic Center and there will be Porta Potties at the Nordic Center and at the World Class Ski Stadium.
- **Waxing:** There is electricity for waxing near the start – finish area at Hillcrest Golf Course and at the Nordic Center but the waxing will be outside in both cases.
- **Parking:** At the Hillcrest Golf Course only team vehicles will be able to park near the start-finish area. Parking is availability near the Hillcrest Golf Club House and it is a short walk or ski to the start-finish area. You can also park in the parking lot north of the Fort Lewis College Stadium and you can either walk or ski to the start finish area. Parking is limited at the Nordic Center. Parking Passes for team vans will be distributed at the Team Captain's meeting 7pm on January 15, 2010. Only Team Vans will be able to park close to the World Class Ski Stadium. We will try and accommodate as many cars as possible at the Nordic Center. Parking maps will be available at the Team Captain's Meeting. Spectators and family members can also park in the parking lot at the Lodge at Purgatory that is directly across the Highway from the Nordic Center. They can also park in one of the parking lots at DMR and take a shuttle to the Nordic Center.

- **Seeding For Saturday's Sprint Qualifying Race & Sunday's Interval Start Races:** Saturday Sprint Qualifier: J2 and Older, Seeding will be done directly off of the USSA NRL points list, then Rocky Mountain Nordic Points List, then random draw. For J3, & J4 Seeding will be done off the RMN JNQ qualifier results from Crested Butte, then a random draw. J5 & J6 male and females will be a random draw. Sunday Interval Start: Seed Groups for Seniors off USSA Points List, J2 and Older will be seed groups off RMN Points List, J3 and J4 Seeding will be off the RMN JNQ results from Crested Butte, J5 & J6 will be random draw. All this is subject to change.
